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## RACE DAY INSTRUCTIONS – FOR RACERS & CREW

### 1. RACER ENVELOPES:

- An envelope with your name will be available for collection at the Gate on Race Day.
- Inside, you'll find:
  1. A copy of your Nomination Form(s)
  2. Blank vehicle Scrutineering Form(s) – to be completed **before** Scrutineering check-in
  3. Gate admission wristbands for you and your crew – please put these on **before** Office check-in

### 2. OFFICE CHECK-IN:

- All participants **must** check in at the Office on Race Day. Failure to do so will result in delays while Tower Officials confirm with Office Officials that your entry to the Event is valid.
- Please bring your Nomination Form(s).
- After Office check-in, you must proceed to the Scrutineering Shed (bring your helmet, and EITHER be dressed in your FULL racing attire OR bring it with you – including footwear).

### 3. SCRUTINEERING CHECK-IN:

#### For Full IHRA Licence Holders:

- Bring your completed CAD Form(s), IHRA Licence, Logbook (if applicable), and helmet to the Scrutineering Shed. Note – please present with your vehicle if identified as “AUDIT” on the paperwork contained in your Racer Envelope.
- You will be required to complete and sign the IHRA Risk & Indemnity Waiver.
- Upon completion, you will be issued a Racer’s wristband (must be worn at all times), and a Scrutineering Sticker (must be adhered to the vehicle).

#### For IHRA Event Licence holders or Civil Driver’s Licence holders:

- Write your Day Licence number in large, clear print on a left-hand side window of your car, or left-hand side position on your bike (must be legible and visible to Tower Officials). A white, chalk marker pen is a good choice for cars. Bikes can attach a temporary sign as desired.
- Bring your completed Off Street Scrutineering Form(s), your vehicle, and helmet to the Scrutineering Shed. You should be fully dressed in your racing attire (or bring it with you) so Officials can check you meet the personal protective safety requirements.
- Any deficiencies identified with your vehicle must be rectified before you can proceed.
- You will be required to complete and sign the IHRA Risk & Indemnity Waiver.
- Upon completion, you will be issued a Racer’s wristband (must be worn at all times), and a Scrutineering Sticker will be placed on the vehicle by the Scrutineering Official.

### 4. TRACK ACCESS PASS (FOR CREW):

- Available at the Office for crew members aged 16 years or older.
- Crew members must complete and sign the IHRA Risk & Indemnity Waiver to receive a “Track Access” wristband (must be worn at all times).
- Please ensure all Crew members are familiar with start line protocols. Non-compliance may result in direction or removal by Track Officials.
